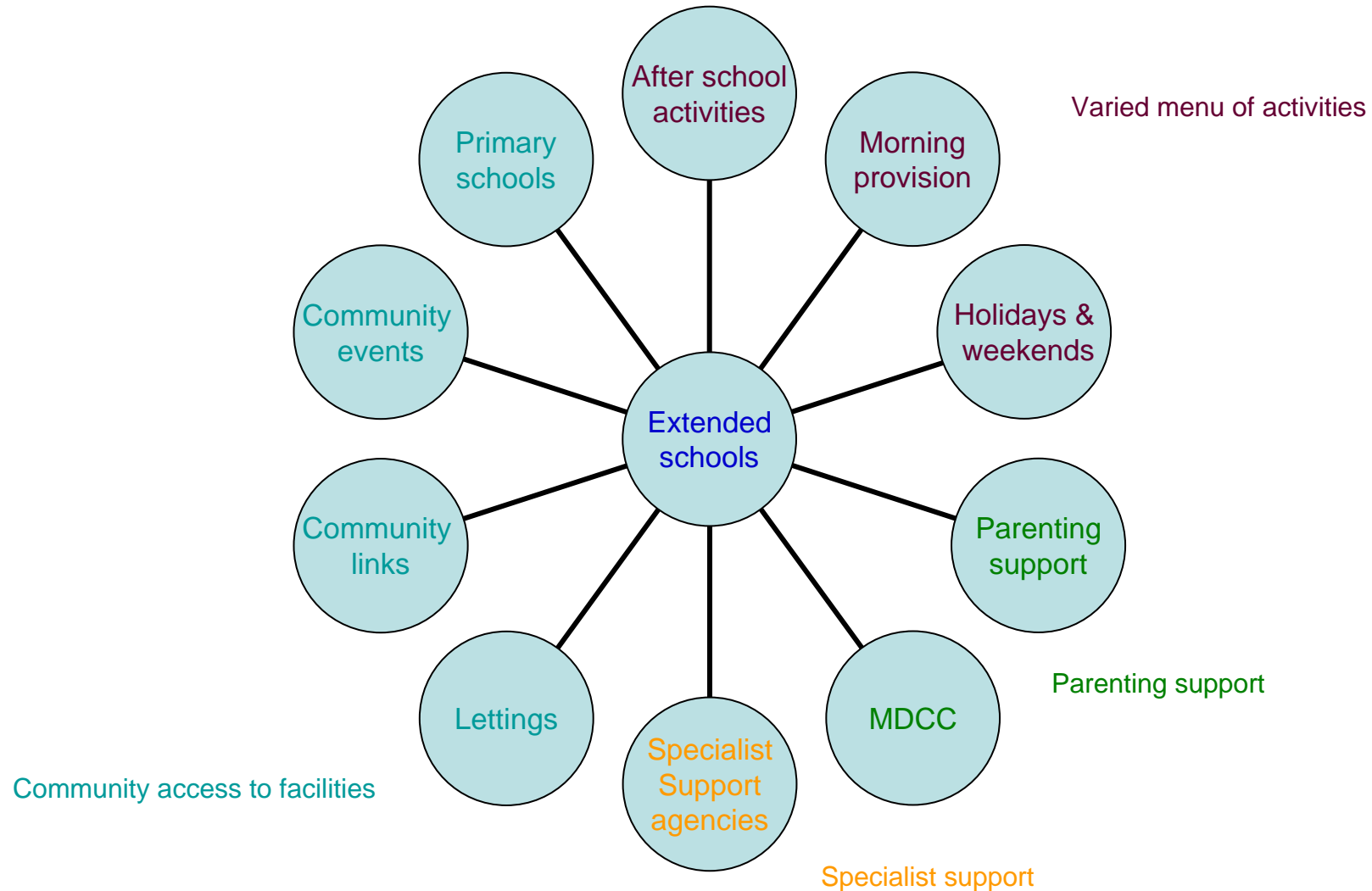


What are Extended Schools?



Why are Extended Schools important?

- **For pupils:**
 - More opportunities for Fun, Sports, Music and Art activities
 - Having somewhere safe to be with friends before and after school
 - Parents being able to help with homework and school work
 - Advice if you need it
- **For parents/carers:**
 - Positive activities and study support
 - Parenting courses, advice and information
 - Greater involvement in their children's learning
 - Adult and Family Learning
 - Use of school facilities
- **For the community:**
 - Access to school facilities
 - Local base for further education courses and other learning opportunities
 - Local access to health and specialist services
 - Promotes feeling of being part of a larger community that includes all ages

What impact will Extended Schools have?

- **Raise Achievement**
- Improved attendance, behaviour and reduce number of exclusions
- Improve self-esteem, confidence and motivation
- Greater enjoyment of school
- Improve relationships with teachers and family
- Feeling valued and trusted within school
- Relevant work experience
